## MULTIPLICATION 3 DIGIT NUMBERS BY 1 DIGIT NUMBER



1. Revise and talk about Place Value of 3 digit numbers.
2. Write the question on the board, multiply 312 by 2 .
3. Let pupils know that the question is asking for 2 groups of 312 .
4. Draw the Place Value chart on the board and prepare some base tens blocks.
5.Select pupil to stick the base ten blocks to the place value chart.
6.Add the ones, tens and then the hundreds to get the answer.
5. Practise students to multiply another 3 digit number by 1 digit number. Example $231 \times 3$
